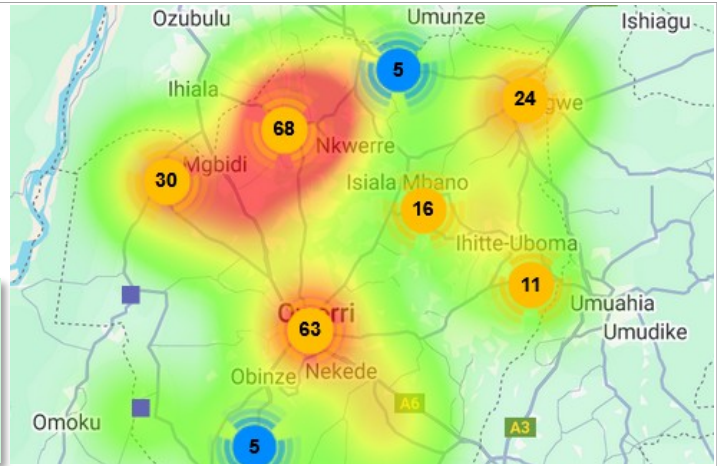
Preventing and Mitigating Criminal Violence and Targeted Killings in Imo State

April 12-18, 2026

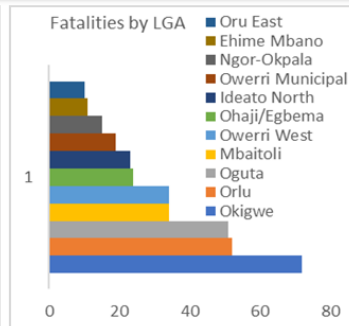
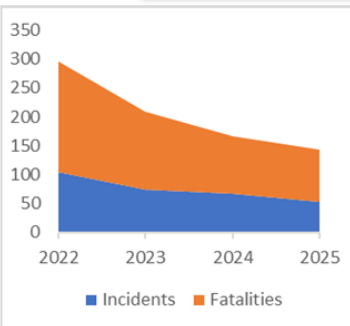

Anticipated Trends and Dynamics

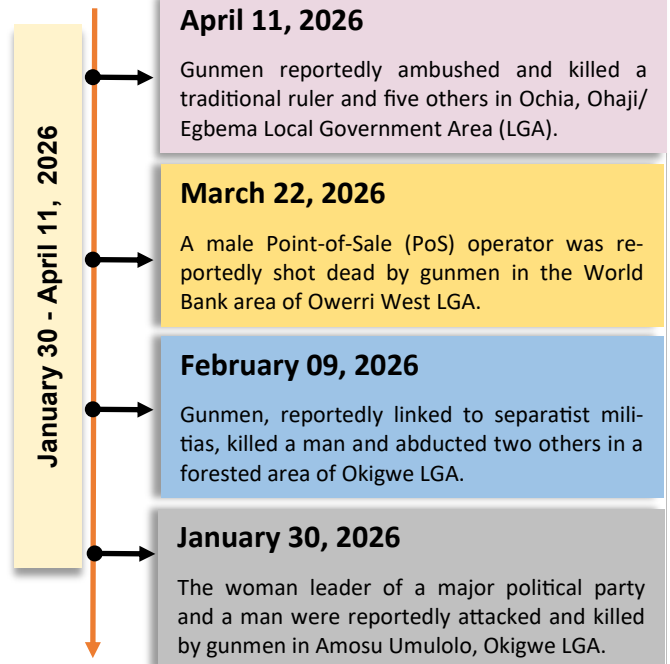

Security agencies have intensified efforts to curb criminal violence through targeted patrols and coordinated operations. In parallel, community leaders are working with law enforcement to strengthen intelligence gathering and enhance response effectiveness.
